We met via zoom. Carol called the meeting to order at 6:02 pm.

Agenda: The agenda was approved.

Minutes: Minutes from the Saturday, March 8, 2022 meeting were approved.

Financial report: We reviewed the financial report for March 2022. The report was approved with one amendment: move coaching expenses from competition to the general account.

Team Reports:

Music: Gayle provided a written report. March coaching with Lea went well and plans are in place for the videography. A discussion arose about what we will do afterward. Gayle said we will work on repertoire. Carol Ann will send out a poll for singing at the Midnight Sun game. Solstice is looking for performers but we would have to sing for an entire hour. Parking is difficult so it would be tough to get there. There is potential to sing at the Salmon Bake.

Communications: Kanza provided a written report. She will resume putting rehearsals in Latitude 65 now that she is back from her trip. The live streaming of rehearsals and coaching is going well and coaching videos were uploaded for viewing on a private YouTube channel. Erin was told to bill Sweet Adelines if she goes over her data plan since she is using her own phone to video everything. Kanza said they experimented with Zoom and Facebook and found that Facebook worked best for streaming. Those who don't have Facebook accounts can watch the videos on YouTube. Kanza will put the Friends and Family invite on Facebook and our website but will not upload the videos until after competition judging is done, otherwise, we would be disqualified (per SAI rules.) We will tell the Friends and Family audience no recordings are allowed.

Membership: Joy was absent but had provided a written report. We have 29 members and two associates. Jackie Lockwood is no longer a prospect. Joy received the necklaces for Sweet Adeline of the Year and the Membership team has been busy preparing for Installation on April 30, 2022. The Management Team expressed their appreciation for Joy for providing housing, meals, and transportation for Lea Beverly.

Production: Jen didn't have anything new to report.

Visual: Janice didn't have anything new to report.

Fundraising: Dody gave a verbal report. She and Carol Ann Varner are reviewing the list of business supporters before sending it out to the chorus. Mary Sweeney has resigned from the Fundraising team.

Old Business:

1. **Coaching:** Lea did a coaching session with a men's barbershop quartet. Lea charges \$40 an hour and the men paid her \$60. Amy and Carol stated that the time spent with Lea is worth the expense. She is very good at what she does and has great credentials and international affiliations.

- 2. Videography: We discussed how to get the risers to Pioneer Park (PP). Kanza said her husband can take the trailer from PJ's to PP but would need help unloading. Carol will call PP to find out where to park the trailer. Kanza said someone would need to get the special riser from the church. Need a pickup with a long enough bed as the risers are 6'. We will announce this need during rehearsal and Jen will oversee the logistics. Janice said the youth group at her church could possibly do this. The decision was made to pay the youth group \$100 if they are available. Further discussion is needed for future riser movement, especially doing the Christmas show without the men's help. We will not be doing a second videography session on the 21st and will take a break that Thursday instead. Kanza suggested we watch our video recording during the April 28th rehearsal.
- 3. **Mask Use:** The chorus will be given individual preference whether to wear a mask or not at rehearsals. It is preferable to not wear a mask during the video recording.
